## **AWARDS**

High point awards are offered in open, all breed, rookie, walk/trot, youth, amateur and L1 youth and amateur classes. Horses must show in four classes under each judge to be eligible. L1 open classes will not count towards all-around awards. All-breed, rookie, Walk/trot, L1 youth and amateur, youth and amateur awards are based on horse/rider combinations, if fewer than three horses are competing for an award, an alternative award may be offered,

Circuit awards are offered for all classes, if fewer than three horses are competing for an award, an alternative award may be offered.

<u>All breed, walk/trot</u>: The youth and open all breed walk/trot classes and all breed WTL will be held concurrently (youth and adults show together), If there are at least three entries in each age group, the classes will be held separately. Separate awards will be given for each age group.

**Dave Hack Custom Chap Certificate**: awarded to the high SCORE amateur cow horse (boxing or fence) under all four judges (scores to be added). In the case of a tie, the highest placing in halter will be used as a tie breaker.

**Kimes Ranch Certificate** will be awarded to the high point amateur ranch rider (ranch riding only) under all four judges (scores to be added). IN case of a tie, the highest placing in halter will be used as a tie breaker.

Daily high point "ship" award: For each set of judges (TH/FRI & SAT/SUN) \$100 will be awarded to the high point amateur, L1 amateur, youth and L1 youth in horsemanship, showmanship and equitation classes combined. If fewer than three horses are competing for the award an alternative award may be offered.

## "THE FINE PRINT"

All classes at Saguaro Classic will be conducted under the rules of AQHA as applicable.

SAQHA and its show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It will be a condition of entry that the exhibitor holds SAQHA and its show management and personnel blameless for any loss, or sickness to his horse, or equipment which may occur from fire, theft or otherwise.

Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed as an additional \$30 office charge.

Class sequence and location: Management reserves the right to adjust the sequence and location of classes.

AzQHA approved shows are assessed \$2.00 per entry to fund year-end awards. This assessment is included in your published entry fee.

Horseshoe Park Rules: Exhibitors are responsible for adhering to the rules of Horseshoe Park regarding the use of motor vehicles on the grounds, pets, and alcohol.
